## 101 Login Page


### Priority: High

### **Priority: Medium**

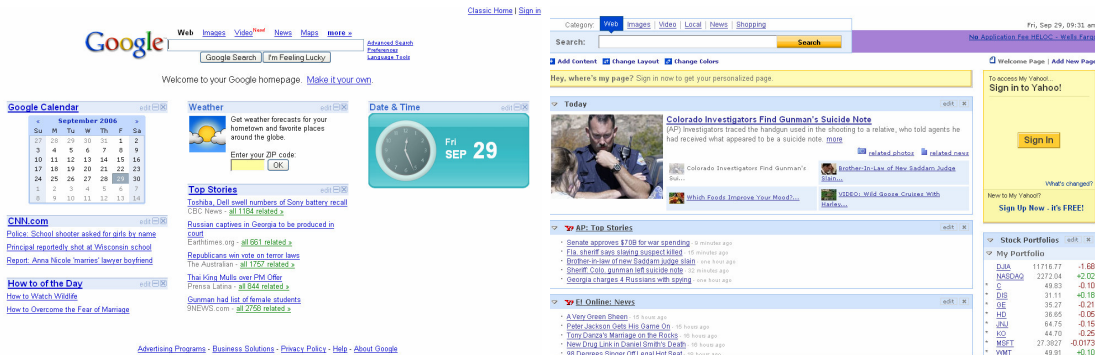
The Modify Settings page will look similar to the Registration page, except that it will only apply to users who have logged in. This will allow logged in users to edit their settings.
